# Safety and Security

The City of Coral Springs is committed to ensuring school safety, which is why we are proud to say that our city was the first municipality in the nation to use the ALERT (Active Law Enforcement Response Technology) software, which integrates security systems directly with the Coral Springs Police Crime Center.

## Real Time Crime Center

The technology implemented using the ALERT software directly addresses the requirements of Alyssa's Law, which mandates mobile panic buttons be installed on every teacher and staff member's cellphone as an app to silently alert law enforcement to emergencies. Our Police Department has demonstrated their commitment to ensuring school safety by implementing new technology connected directly into our Real Time Crime Center (RTCC). Using advanced software, security systems are integrated directly into the RTCC improving response times and saving critical seconds during emergency situations - when time matters the most.

## School Resource Officer Program

The City of Coral Springs Police Department understands it is important for parents to have open lines of communication with their child's teacher, school administrators and officers on campus during school hours.
